Background

myCGS is a self-service, web-based application developed specifically to serve the needs of health care providers and their staff in Jurisdiction 15. It offers:

- Availability 24/7
- Services and functions that are FREE of charge
- Access to beneficiary eligibility, claim and payment information, forms allowing you to submit redetermination requests, and respond to Medical Review Additional Documentation Requests (ADR), and much more.

To use myCGS, providers must have an Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) agreement on file with CGS.

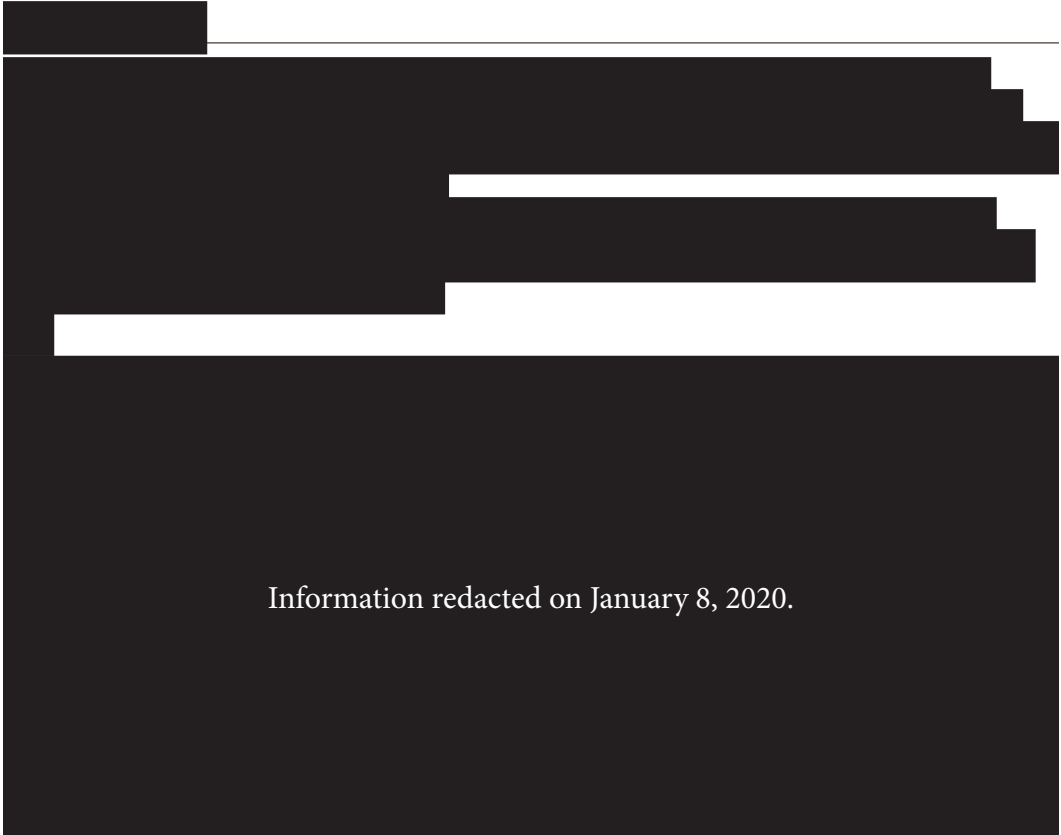

Security Matters! Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) Option

What is MFA? CGS implemented the Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) to enhance the security of Medicare data, as well as myCGS user data. **This feature is optional.** MFA offers an extra layer of security to help keep your myCGS account secure even if someone manages to obtain your password without your knowledge..

How to Activate MFA

1. When logging into myCGS, you can choose to turn the MFA feature on by accessing the **My Account** tab.
2. Once MFA is successfully activated, you will be presented with a verification page.
3. You can choose to receive an eight-digit verification code via text (if a mobile phone number was entered on the **My Account** tab), or via an email message.
4. Each time you access myCGS, you will receive the eight-digit verification code via the option you previously selected (text or email). Once the verification code is entered, you will have access to the myCGS website portal.
