Question from Missy: Based on the new refill requirements, for items billed with a date span and may overlap another date billed within the 10-day window, will the claims deny?

Denise responded that the system is set up to allow claims billed that may overlap. Tonia confirmed that she has not had denials for claims billed with overlap dates of service.

Mary Ellen asked if POE could create a tool for enteral nutrition that will assist suppliers billing a 30-day supply.

- Denise asked for topic suggestions for the Ask the Contractor Meeting (ACM).
 - The group suggested Therapeutic Shoes for Persons with Diabetes and Continuous Glucose Monitors

 - Rose stated she will be sending a speaker request for the April meeting.

VI. Feedback & Suggestions/Open Discussion

- Denise asked members to continue to think and provide ideas to enhance CGS's educational efforts.
 - Valarie suggested an update to the PAP Dear Physician letter for information about the delay in PAP set up. This is in reference to the following FAQ:
 - What is needed to obtain a CPAP if there is a long period of time between the original in-person and sleep test/polysomnogram and when the beneficiary actually obtains and starts on the CPAP? For example, what if the beneficiary goes for an in-person visit to assess for obstructive sleep apnea (OSA) in March of 2016 and has a qualifying sleep test in April of 2016, but didn't obtain and start using the CPAP until May of 2017?
 - While a few months' delay in obtaining a CPAP could be understandable, over a year would be harder to justify. A new evaluation by the treating practitioner would need to be provided to explain the delay and, because a lot of things can change medically/ physically for the beneficiary in that year, a new sleep test or titration study may be appropriate.
