She then reviewed the clarification published in the Lower Limb policy regarding consolidated billing.

This revision is a clarification of custom prostheses that are excluded from the skilled nursing facility (SNF) consolidated billing (CB) rule. There is no change to the codes excluded from CB that are now referred to as the major category III codes.
